Accommodation and Safety

Delegates to the Clinic on the Meaningful Modelling of Epidemiological Data will be accommodated at the Empire Building, Beach Road, Muizenberg which is within walking distance to and from AIMS. Single and shared accommodation will be provided.

As in any foreign country, visitors are advised to be aware and alert when travelling to avoid falling prey to petty theft and crime. Most areas and attractions of South Africa can be safely visited but for your own safety it it important that you do not walk around late at night. Always be discreet with expensive camera equipment and jewellery and be aware of your surroundings
